The ARC participates in the International Symposium on Agriculture Innovation for Family Farmers organised by the FAO in Rome, Italy.

Pretoria: The Agricultural Research Council is participating in the International Symposium on Agricultural Innovation for Family Farmers hosted by the Food and Agricultural Organization of the United Nations (FAO) from 21-23 November 2018. Agricultural scientists and farmers are converging at FAO headquarters in Rome, Italy to discuss and deliberate under the theme "Unlocking the potential agricultural innovations to achieve Sustainable Developmental Goal".

The ARC CEO Dr Shadrack Moephuli is joining international delegations, agricultural scientists and farmers to discuss innovations in agriculture and their potential to alleviate poverty. The ARC's participation at the conference emphasise the role it's playing in the supporting the programs of government in alleviating poverty and hunger.
