Procedure for the depositing of fungal specimens in the National Collection of Fungi:

1. Deposit dry, metabolic inactive material
 - a. Cultures: Fully grown, non contaminated, mite free cultures should be dried on 15% glycerol plates or over a water bath with steam
 - b. Material on the substrate should be air dried and carefully mounted on carton and wrapped with cellophane.
2. Place cultures in appropriate holder
3. Mark clearly with all relevant information (species name, host or substrate, date of collection, locality, collector, depositor as well as relevant literature).
4. Please clearly indicate whether or not the specimen represents a holo/para or neotype.
5. Send of to National Collection of Fungi

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6. Please note that no PREM numbers will be reserved or allocated to specimens of which the all the relevant collection data were not provided.
